Vocational resource support

Construction training; Digital and IT training; Education and childcare training; and Health and social care training; services are subscription services. This page covers what is included in a subscription, how to subscribe, the types of subscription packages and how the pricing works. Content

Jisc's vocational learning services are packed with engaging resources and supplementary material for FE practitioners to use in teaching and learning. They make it easy to find and embed engaging, curriculum-ready resources for your learners. The services are curriculum mapped to NVQ/SVQ/VRQ level 2 and 3 qualifications as well as being mapped to the latest National Occupational Standards (NOS). The services are also relevant to many BTEC units. Links to the curriculum, learning outcomes and NOS keywords are made explicit and content is continually updated to remain mapped to the NOS and relevant FE curriculum, supporting future employment demands.

How pricing works

To subscribe to Jisc's [Vocational learning resources](#), you need a [Jisc Collections](#) account. Speak to a member of your learning resources/library team to find out who your Jisc Collections account owner is.

Once you're logged into Jisc collections, your college can subscribe to the FREE 60-day trials. We'll email your account owner within 2 working days to confirm access and send helpful information and top tips to make the most of your trials.

Transaction fees are charged per invoice raised. How to subscribe

Prerequisites

Your organisation must be:

- In the United Kingdom (UK)
- A Further Education (FE) organisation or independent training provider (ITP) in receipt of government funding
- Have a [Jisc collections](#) account
- Set up with an [UKAMF Identity provider \(IdP\)](#)

Types of subscription

These are the types of subscription, which are administered through [Jisc collections](#).

- Standard price subscription
- 60-day trial – for 60 days you can try the service for free, explore the full catalogue of resources and discover how the services work

Steps to subscribe

1. Check that you meet the pre-requisites (listed above)
2. Find the 60-day trial or annual subscription on the Jisc Collections page
3. Sign in to Jisc collections; if you don't have a Jisc collections account, contact your [Jisc account manager](#) to sign up.
4. Select 'pricing and subscription information' tab
5. Read the 'licence terms document' and the 'detailed pricing document'
6. Return to the overview tab
7. Select the red 'subscribe now' button below the subscription title

8. [Proceed to purchase the agreement for the account](#) – this is only available for accounts authorised to purchase on behalf of the organisation
9. The primary contact on your Jisc collections account will receive a confirmation email with helpful links to the service and supporting material
10. Staff and students will be able to access the resources using their organisational log in details.

Pro-Rata

Subscriptions last until the end of the academic year (31/07/##) so the months of the academic year that have passed at the point of subscription are deducted from the cost.
